



WARNINGS AND REMINDERS

- 1. Adult supervision is required for participants of age 6-8 years.
- 2. Please be advised that the potting mix contains traces of minerals. Do not ingest. Wash hands thoroughly before and after handling potting mix.
- 3. Learning kit contains small parts. To avoid the risk of suffocation, keep all wrappers and plastic materials away from babies, toddlers and young children.

INSTRUCTIONS

Learning Objectives:

Transplanting sunflower seedling into a new pot.

Witness transplant shock, and learn to care for sunflower seedling.



STEP 1:

Place felt fabric at the base of the pot.



STEP 2:

Add a bag of potting mix into the pot.



STEP 3:

Sprinkle a little insect frass over the potting mix into the pot.



STEP 4:

Transplant seedling into the pot.



STEP 5:

Add the other bag of potting mix into the pot. Adjust the potting mix to keep the seedling in place.



STEP 6:

Sprinkle a little insect frass over the potting mix into the pot.
Keep the remaining insect frass for weekly fertilizing.



STEP 7:

Water the pot thoroughly until water seeps through from the bottom of the pot.
This will help the seedling recover from transparent shock (wilting effect)



STEP 8:

Place in an area with >6hrs of direct light.
Water seedling every day. Add a small amount of insect frass weekly.
Transplant sunflower seedling to a bigger pot or garden once it out grows the current pot.



SUPPLEMENTARY DETAILS

1. Plant Care:

- a. Take care when transplanting, sunflower roots are delicate. Water thoroughly after transplanting for seedling to recover.
- b. Sunflowers take up to 120 days to grow.
- c. Water and fertilize regularly and make sure the medium is well drained.
- d. Sunflowers' roots develop rapidly and form mass, ensuring the plant is transplanted to prevent root bound.

2. System Care:

- a. Wash the pot thoroughly after the sunflower is transplanted out.
- b. The pot is durable and can be used to germinate or used as a container for other plants or relevant size.

3. Excess Material Storage:

a. Store excess insect frass in cool, dark and dry locations. Keep out of reach from toddlers and young children.
